Albert (A.A.) Röell, Chairman of the Managing Board



Albert Röell (1959) joined the Managing Board of KAS BANK N.V. on 1 December 2004 and was appointed chairman of the Managing Board in May 2005. Albert Röell is responsible for the focus areas New Business Development, Internal Audit, Human Resources & Organisation Development, Secretariat, Risk Management and Compliance.

As chairman of the Managing Board, Röell is responsible for the general strategy of KAS BANK. "Pure play' rests on in-depth knowledge of our industry, innovative power and absolute neutrality and independence. Based on its high-quality securities services and advanced technology, the bank increasingly focuses on added value services provided to institutional investors and financial institutions."

Rolf Kooijman (1961) joined KAS BANK on 1 January 2009 as Chief Financial Officer (CFO). With effect from 22 April 2009, he has been appointed member of KAS BANK's Managing Board. His most significant focus areas include Financial and Management Accounting, Legal, Treasury, Investment Management Services (IMS) and Facility Management.

As CFO, Rolf Kooijman is responsible for the organisation's return and risk as well as a transparent insight into KAS BANK's performance. "The continuous consideration between managing risk, return and solvency is most certainly a challenge in these special times."

Rolf Kooijman studied accountancy at the Royal Netherlands Institute of Registered Accountants (NIVRA). After several positions at large audit firms, he made a switch to the financial sector in 1994. Kooijman has a broad experience in composing multidisciplinary and multinational teams.

Sikko (S.A.J.) van Katwijk, Member of the Managing Board, Chief Commercial Officer



With effect from 1 July 2009, Sikko van Katwijk (1964) has been appointed member of the Managing Board and Chief Commercial Officer (CCO) of KAS BANK N.V. His most significant focus areas are the market segments Institutional Investors and Financial Institutions, Institutional Risk Management and Marketing.

As CCO Van Katwijk will be primarily responsible for marketing, sales and relationship management. "I will particularly focus on further strengthening the bank's client base and our role as pure player in the European securities industry."

Van Katwijk studied Public Administration at the Erasmus University in Rotterdam and Business Administration at the Indiana University in Bloomington (USA). He also attended several training courses in the securities services area both in the Netherlands and abroad.
